Increase the Power of the Presidency:

- By giving the president more direct influence over the Department of Justice.
- By having the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) more responsive to the president.

Eliminating Specific Federal Departments:

- <u>Eliminate the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau</u>
- Eliminate the Housing and Urban Development Department
- <u>Eliminate the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation</u>
- Eliminate the Corporation for Public Broadcasting
- Eliminate the National Foundation on the Arts and Humanities
- Eliminate the Federal Housing Finance Agency (Fannie Mae & Freddie Mac)
- Eliminate the Corporation for National & Community Service (Ameri-Corps)
- Eliminate the Export-Import Bank (capital & credit insurance to facilitate US exports
- Eliminate the US Trade & Development Agency (transfer to private sector)

Reduction in the Scope of Specific Federal Departments:

- Department of Veteran Affair
 - Eliminate 42 offices to allow for barrier-free access to expert employees
 - Consolidate 31 additional offices
- Federal Communications Commission (FCC)
 - 。 End review of telecommunication mergers
 - <u>Transfer broad-band competition enforcement to the Federal</u> <u>TradeCommission (FTC)</u>
- Department of Transportation



- <u>Privatize federal management of transportation services such as Amtrak and</u> <u>Air Traffic Control</u>
- <u>Downsize federal role in highway funding transfer responsibilities to the</u> <u>states</u>
- Eliminate Federal Transit Administration decrease support for mass transit projects; eliminate airport improvement program; and Maritime Administration
- Department of Homeland Security
 - End the National Flood Insurance program
 - <u>Contract out the Transportation Security Administration</u>
- Department of Labor
 - <u>Eliminate the Office of Federal Compliance Program Office</u> <u>monitors federal contractors from engaging in racial discrimination</u>
 - Eliminate the trade adjustment assistance program program is established to help American workers who lose jobs to foreign competitors
- Environmental Protection Administration

• Gut the department

- Department of Commerce
 - Eliminate census bureau funding for the annual supplemental poverty measure report
 - Eliminate minority business development agency
 - Consider privatizing the Weather Service
- Department of Energy
 - Draw down the strategic petroleum reserve
 - Eliminate many offices and programs
 - Assist in the revocation of the executive order for global green energy mandates and industrial energy efficiencies
- Office of Personnel Management
 - <u>Eliminate the multi-state plan program under the Affordable Care Act</u> (ACA)of 2010 - this will jeopardize the ACA
 - Eliminate special congressional subsidies for health insurance this will jeopardize the ACA
- Social Security Administration
 - Eliminate non-vocational grids and person's ability to adjust to work from Social Security disability insurance determination
 - Test optional private disability insurance
 - Privatize disability insurance payments
- Department of Health and Human Services
 - **<u>Sunset the Head Start Program</u>**
 - Transfer low-income housing assistance to the states
 - Repeal patient-centered health care reform
 - Cease the implementation of the Affordable Care Act.

Expansion of "Additional" New Services to Specific Departments:



- Department of Energy
 - Increase all liquified natural gas exports
- Department of the Treasury
 - Financial crimes enforcement regulation should be subject to meaningful costbenefit analysis
- Office of Management and Budget
 - Organize existing offices into Division of Evidence-Based Policy
- Securities and Exchange Commission
 - Create Complex Case Unit to handle cases involving large, complex, and wellfinanced investment banks, banks, and investment companies
- National Security Council
 - <u>Hire team players</u>
- Social Security Administration
 - Establish a needs-based period for disability benefits
- Department of Homeland Security (DHS)
 - Empower the DHS security management policy and implementation
- Department of Health and Human Services
 - Implement a means test welfare reform effort
 - Slow down the rate of spending in the Medicare program
- Department of State
 - Correct all the inefficiencies and structural problems in the department and America's foreign assistance programs and treaties
- Department of the Interior
 - Revoke the fracking regulations
 - Open oil exploration in the outer continental shelf
 - <u>Review the legal status of the US territories to determine whether the</u> <u>association with the US should be continued</u>
- Department of Defense
 - Increase the size of the military

Balance the Federal Budget:

- <u>Cut taxes for the rich and the corporations</u>
- <u>Cut spending (entitlements)</u>
- <u>Restoring Economic Freedom</u>
 - <u>Reduce the Federal Reserve's discretion in monetary policy and implement a</u> rules-based policy that moves the US toward a competitive monetary system
 - **<u>Repeal the Affordable Care Act</u>**
 - <u>Medicare should transition to a defined-contribution, premium support</u> <u>model</u>



- <u>Medicaid must be a "true safety net" abled-bodied individuals should be</u> <u>converted to direct, defined contribution to facilitate participation in the</u> <u>private marketplace</u>
- ^o <u>Reform Social Security by benefits reduction, re-evaluation or both</u>
- **Protection of Life and Conscience (anti-abortion stance)**
- Mandatory work requirements for abled-bodied adult food stamp recipients
