We voted in the CADEM Pre-Endorsement forum. We have club delegates, DPCCC delegates that are members of this club and people who ran to be an elected DPCCC delegate. Results:

Senate District 3 (Brentwood, Oakley, Discovery Bay, Byron, Knightsen, Bethel Island and part of Senator Dodd's district) - No consensus meaning no one obtained enough votes to be places on the consent calendar. The three candidates are Christopher Cabaldon, Rozzana Verder-Aliga and Jackie Elward. Their websites:

Senate District 9 (Antioch, Pittsburg heading west to Crockett and San Leandro) - Marisol Rubio received 64% and Tim Grayson received 28% of the vote. Neither candidate reached 70% so it will go to an endorsement vote at the convention.

Assembly District 15- Monica Wilson won her endorsement with 80% of the vote. Her name goes on the consent calendar for the formal endorsement vote on 11/17-11/18.
