 - 1. Report on CalDem primary election endorsement meeting, which was held virtually on the weekend of March 6 (A list of Democratic candidates for statewide office is enclosed.)

 - (a) The Endorsement Committee is working to finalize the MCDC endorsement questionnaire.
 - (b) At our April 10 General Meeting, each candidate seeking MCDC endorsement for the June 7 primary may give a 3-minute talk regarding his or her qualifications and reasons for running for office. To date, three of the four Democratic candidates for Clerk (Devlin Murphy, Vicki Gordon, and Kristen Connelly) have requested our endorsement. Floy Andrews has requested MCDC endorsement for Assessor. Members will be able to ask a few questions of each candidate following the candidate's presentation. Candidates will make their presentations one at a time, while the others remain in a waiting room.
