<p>Argentina's Disappeared:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Occurred between 1976-1983 • During a period of military dictatorship • Cause: Suppression of Political Opposition. The military regime targeted various groups perceived as a threat to their authority, such as leftist guerilla groups, members of political parties, moderate Peronists, <u>trade unionists, students, professors, journalists, artists, and human rights advocates.</u> • Called the "Dirty War:" it is estimated that between 10,000-30,000 people were disappeared. • Methods used: Abduction from homes and workplaces to clandestine detention centers, torture & extrajudicial killings with bodies secretly disposed of including by being thrown from airplanes into the sea, systematic abduction of children who were often then illegally adopted. • Grandmothers and mothers brought attention to the plight of the disappeared and advocated for justice; After the return of civilian rule in 1983 the National Commission of the Disappearance of Persons worked with the democratically elected government to investigate the disappearances; Several military leaders were prosecuted and convicted for their roles in human rights abuses. There continues to be an ongoing 	<p>Present United States Immigrant Practices: Under the authority of Donald Trump, and guidance of Steven Miller, Kristie Noem, & Tom Homan:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <i>Is this an attempt to turn ICE into a National Police Force , accountable to no one, to do what they want with innocent people?</i> • The citizens of the US were led to believe that major criminals, gang members & drug dealers would be deported as a way to protect US citizens. • However, presently that has expanded greatly to include any undocumented individual. • Roundups at stores, schools, parks, workplaces, churches, and homes are occurring regularly. • ICE officers are masked and heavily armed, uniforms show no identification, and officers refuse to verbally identify themselves. (Are they all ICE officials?) • People are not provided <u>due process</u>, before being arrested, handcuffed, and taken away. Some have been beaten and a few have died. • United States <u>citizens</u> have also been subjected to these actions, even when some have shown papers showing that they are US citizens. • Some of these roundups have immigrants deported out of the US to detention/internment centers in El Salvador (CECOT), Sudan, and other countries without due process.

<p>search for remaining Disappeared and justice for victims.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It does not appear that DHS will provide a complete list of those who have been put in detention/internment centers with horrendous conditions within the US (e,g,)center in Florida),or deported to other countries. (thus, they are <u>Disappeared</u>) • Court orders continue to be largely ignored. (Are these lawyers and government officials guilty of Contempt of Court for which they should be held accountable?) • There appears to be very strong evidence of racial/ethnic profiling. • The use of the CA National Guard and the Marines in Los Angeles appear to be unconstitutional. • Members of Congress and/or other governmental officials are routinely being denied entry to detention/internment facilities to observe and investigate. • Private for profit facilities are being used as detention/internment centers; at what cost?? • How many non-criminals and/or US citizens have actually been subjected to this abomination and where are they????
